He added: "Of course it would be much better if even more people also joined Neighbourhood Watch. Later on I will be speaking to Rudolph and his mates to sign them up as well, because sometimes they need to chill out around the streets while I run a few errands, especially late at night when it is generally quiet around town. They tend to keep out of sight, but they can keep their eyes, ears and noses open whilst they are patiently waiting."
