- Gatwick Airport Ltd (GAL) has submitted its final detailed proposal to the Airports Commission based on their preferred option for a "full wide spaced runway" (the most damaging to Crawley and the wider South East environment).
- The Airport Commission is considering this as an alternative to a third runway at Heathrow; all other potential options have now been discarded.
- The Commission's public consultation is scheduled for this autumn.
- This public meeting is an opportunity for all those that oppose a second Gatwick runway to have their voices and their concerns heard for the:
  - Destruction of our environment.
  - Lack of infrastructure: roads, schools, hospitals, public transport, water, etc.
  - Increased air and noise pollution from both airport and increased traffic.
  - Risk of further flooding.
  - Urbanisation and loss of countryside.

- GAL admits that most economic benefits will go to businesses and areas outside Crawley.
