

Gatwick Airport Station Upgrade



Network Rail, in partnership with Gatwick Airport Ltd, Coast to Capital Local Enterprise Partnership and the Department for Transport, has submitted plans for a bigger, better Gatwick Airport station.

The proposals aim to relieve crowding at the station, improve passenger flow and provide better connections between the station, airport terminals and onward travel destinations.

Improved passenger information

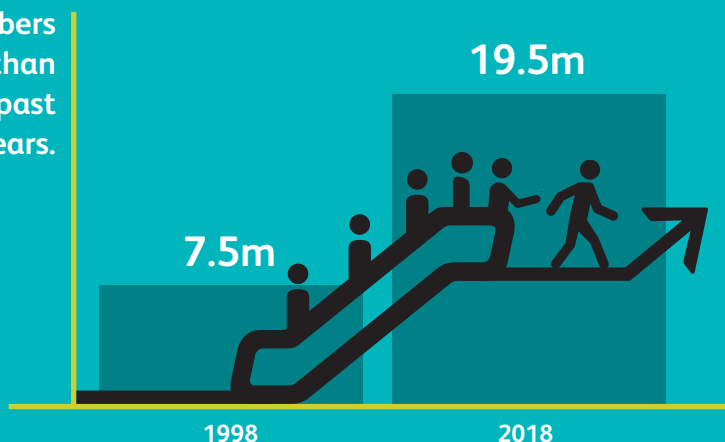
Better connections to the south terminal



Growing demand

Formerly known as Gatwick Racecourse station, the current station was opened by British Rail in May 1958, with major reconstruction and renovation works carried out in the late 1960s, 1980s and most recently in 2013.
